Across crossroads to T junction. Turn right, entrance on left next to vets. From West: M4 (Junction 8/9) to Maidenhead (A308) under railway bridge. Follow road to roundabout. Take 3rd exit (A4 to Slough). At next roundabout, 1st left (B4447). 2nd right (Ray Mill Road West). Turn left at T junction, entrance on left next to vets.**
